forward to seeing you in 2025.



People said they were listened to by support staff but were not listened to by the government.




Lots of people said they did not feel safe in public.






If the weather is nice, our van will be on the High Street at Boscombe Market.






Join us for a drink and something to eat at this months speaking up session in Christchurch.










Join us for a speaking up session on our monthly topic and then a game of bowling after.

18 holes of mini golf at Mr Mulligans Bournemouth. The course is not accessible for people who use wheelchairs or have mobility needs.




